

To our cosplayers who registered to participate in the "Glamoured to Life" Cosplay Show:

Check-in will be available at the Info Counter (see map - number 2) on Saturday, 21 October from the conclusion of the opening ceremony until 6:00 PM, and on Sunday, 22 October from 10:00 AM to 12:00 PM.

At this year's Fan Festival we have scheduled a number of meet and greet sessions for you. These sessions will feature various members of the FFXIV team and our musical guest performers who will appear in multiple sessions throughout Saturday and Sunday.

Please note that we will not be able to accommodate all attendees. In our effort to create a fair system, tickets to all sessions will be raffled via QR code randomly.

The QR code can be found within the Goody Bag that you can collect from the Info Counter on Saturday and Sunday. Please review the information found by scanning the QR code regarding the time, type of session and the attending quests.

To ensure that everyone with a ticket can participate in their session, please ensure that you arrive on time at the meet and greet area on the right-hand side of the Info Counter. Ticket holders who arrive after the starting time of the session may not be guaranteed to participate.

During the signing sessions, personal items cannot be autographed but 2 commemorative mini posters will be prepared and provided. We appreciate your understanding.

Please choose your 3 preferred meet and greet slots. Raffles will take place 1 hours prior to the meet and greet session. Please make sure to scan the QR code a second time 1 hour prior to the meet and greet to see if you have won one of your 3 choices.

Please note that each attendee can only win 1 meet and greet slot.

ADDITIONAL ATTENDEE AMENITIES

FIRST AID [SEE MAP - NUMBER 10]

The first aid room can be found inside North Hall 8. There will be a sign directing attendees to the first aid room. This room will be open from 8:00 AM - 8:00 PM on Saturday, 21 October and 8:00 AM - 8:30 PM on Sunday, 22 October.

QUIET ROOM [SEE MAP - NUMBER 9]

We have created a separate space for attendees who would like to take a moment to catch their breath and relax without the crowds. The Quiet Room is in North Hall 8, right next to the registration area. There will be ample signage pointing attendees there. We ask that everyone be mindful of others there and keep any noise to a bare minimum.

COSPLAY REPAIR ROOM

[SEE MAP - NUMBER 6]

We have created a space on the show floor for attendees who need to adjust or change aspects of the cosplay they're wearing. The cosplay repair room can be found in North Hall 9. We will also be providing a few items that may help to touch up or make minor repairs to a part of your outfit.

We will have different changing areas within the room (blocked by curtains), but these are not intended to be used as the main method for changing into or out of a cosplay. There are not enough rooms for everyone to use for this purpose, so please consider this an additional method to assist attendees who need to make some adjustments or changes while at the event. Also, if you are coming to the event in cosplay, please remember to adhere to all of our costume guidelines (sqex.to/r7D4p).

CLOAKROOM

The cloakrooms are located on level 0 (down the stairs, in between hall entrances N4 & S4) and at the east end of the venue on level 0. Please note ExCel London is unable to store any items overnight and cameras, laptop equipment or any other electronic devices cannot be stored in the cloakroom at any time. Please note that there is limited space available. We therefore advise attendees to leave their belongings in their hotel room or another secure off-site location.

LOST AND FOUND

Any items that you find that may belong to another attendee may be turned into Lost and Found at the Info Counter (see map - number 2). If you misplace an item, please visit the Info Counter and ask the staff for assistance.

ACCESSIBILITY GUIDANCE FOR OUR DISABLED VISITORS

Square Enix strives to support the Disabled Community. As part of our efforts, we have designated a registration area to accommodate attendees with disabilities.

On arrival into the venue, you will see a sign directing attendees within the registration area labelled "Partners, Press, Cosplayers and Disabled Visitors".

Instead of joining the general queue, please proceed directly to the designated area, where you will receive further guidance and support. When utilising the disability entrance into the event, simply alert the staff to your needs so they can assist you as necessary.

You will also receive an additional wristband to highlight your ability to utilise specially-marked areas throughout the event.

We have also added a specially-marked area in front of the stage for our disabled visitors (not limited to attendees with mobility issues). This includes areas with room for those with mobility issues, wheelchairs and chairs next to them for a +1. These seats are easily identifiable.

We have done our utmost to ensure there is dedicated space for those who require it, though there may not be enough seats to guarantee one for every attendee with a disability and their +1. These will be available on a first-come, first-served basis.

Should these specially marked seats not be in use during a stage event by an attendee with a disability, then they may be used by other attendees. However, should the seat be needed by an attendee with a disability, then staff will ask for it to be vacated.

SECURITY AND EVENT DETAILS

OUTSIDE ITEM RESTRICTIONS & PERMISSIONS

We have created a non-exhaustive list of items and behaviours that are prohibited and permitted within the event halls to ensure that security checks conducted before entering the venue proceed smoothly.

Prohibited:

- No alcohol.
- No functional weapons, firearms, knives, etc. of any kind.
- No strollers, luggage, bags with wheels.
- No bags that are larger than a small backpack (55 x 40 x 20cm.).
- No folding chairs.
- No drones.
- No laser pointers or flashlights.
- No vaping or smoking within the venue.
- No illegal substances or drugs of any kind.
- No sharp, hazardous, flammable, glass, or explosive materials.
- Any activity prohibited by law and/or prohibited by any Event facilities.

Permitted:

- Food and non-alcoholic drinks for personal use only.
- Cosplay props that have been checked and adhere to our costume guidelines (sqex.to/r7D4p).
- Bags that meet the following criteria:
 - The Fan Festival 2023 Goody Bag.
 - Bags that are not bigger than a small backpack $(55 \times 40 \times 20 \text{cm})$.
 - Bags received from the Merchandise Booth.
- Any prescribed medication that has been legally obtained and is being used in its intended dosage.
- Any over-the-counter medication being used at the recommended manufacturer dosage level.
- Trained service animals if needed.
